

What to BRING...

Mandatory:

- Current medications in original bottles
- Bible (If needed, one will be provided)
- Enough pants, shirts, socks, underwear, & shorts for one week (Pants are required for horseback riding)
- Gym shoes (closed toe shoes are required for horseback riding)
- Extra clothes that can get dirty (ie. grass stains)
- Raincoat or poncho
- A warm outfit (sweat shirt and jeans or sweat pants) in case it gets cold
- Something to sleep in (please be modest)
- Sunscreen. A hat and sunglasses are highly recommended. Don't get burned.
- Bug spray
- Toiletries – shampoo, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant,
- At least one towel (but you may want another one for swimming)
- A pillow & sleeping bag (or a blanket/sheets)
- A swimsuit (must wear a 1 piece)
- A great attitude
- Notebook, pen, and backpack
- Flashlight

Optional

- Water bottle
- Camera, film, & batteries
- Earplugs (for water or sleeping)
- A pair of zip off pants (for horse back riding)

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Ipod, Radio, Walkman, or electronic games. Any item that might get lost, stolen, or pull you apart from the group. Campers will have plenty to do at camp.
- Knives & other dangerous items
- Snacks and candy, including gum.
- Bad attitudes
- \$. Money is not needed or allowed at camp.
- Watches
- Magazines
